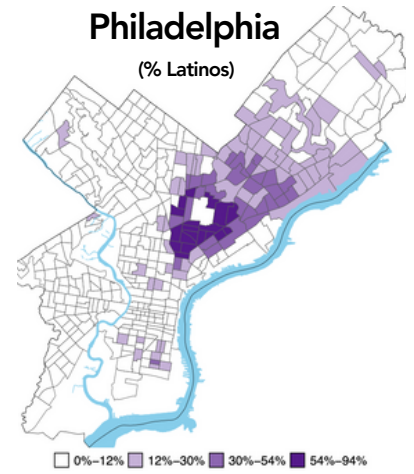
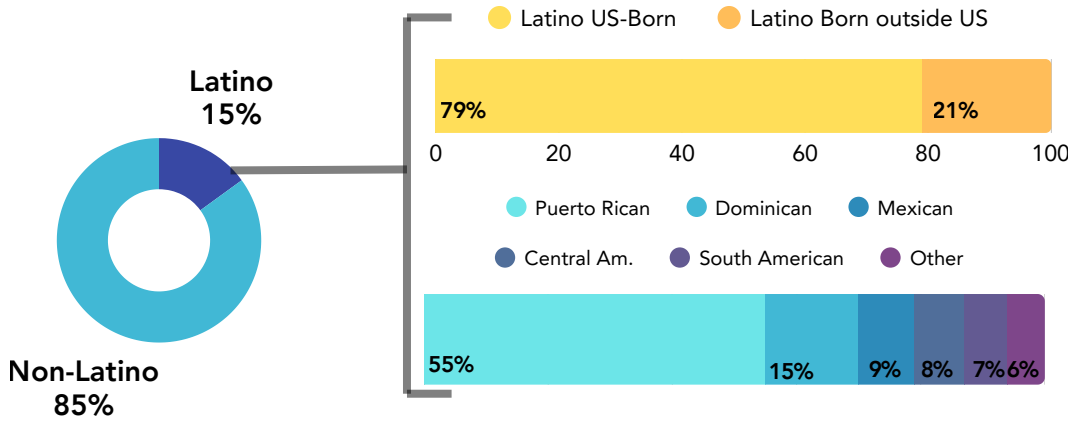


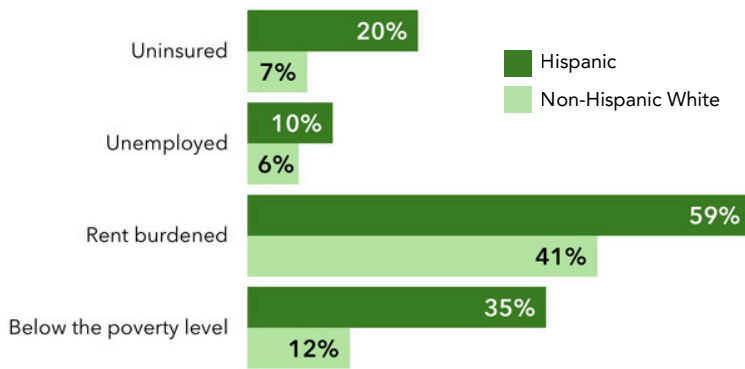
Latinos in Philadelphia

Philadelphia residents who identify as Latino or Hispanic account for 15% of the Philadelphia population. *Philadelphia's Latino population roughly doubled in size between 2000 and 2022, increasing from around 130,000 to 252,400.*

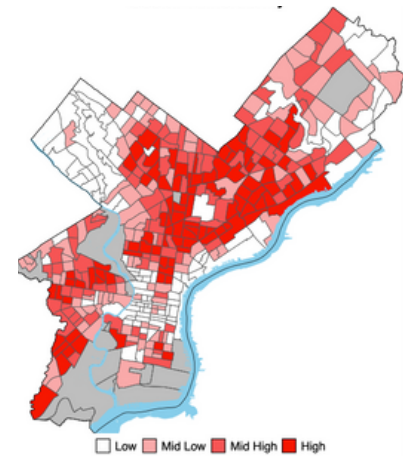
Distribution of Latinos in Philadelphia



Latinos in Philadelphia face a range of social and economic disparities at the individual level and where they live.



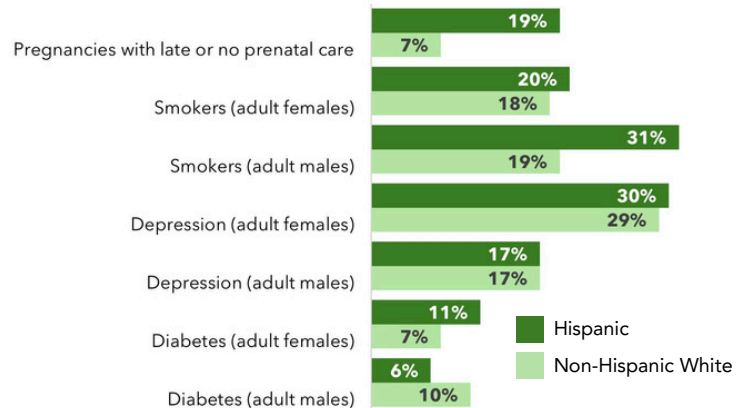
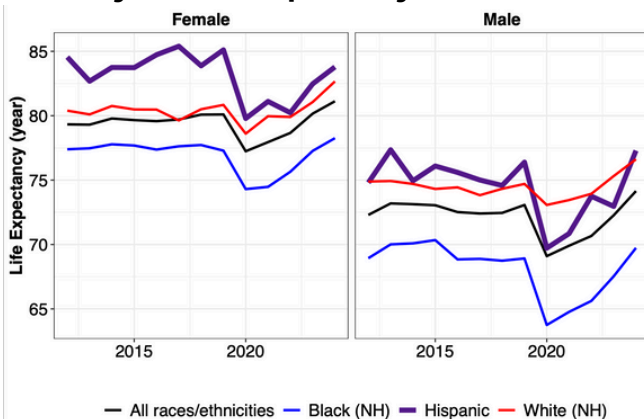
Social Vulnerability Index
